FAQs

How long should we allow for a visit?

We recommend allowing a minimum of three hours to fully explore all the Museum. The Heritage Boat Tour takes an hour, so if you go for the Platinum Package allow four hours. Please note the Heritage Boat Tour runs at specific times during the year - please contact us for availability.

Is there coach parking?

The drop off point is in the Maritime Car Park. Coaches are asked to park at Gyllyngvase Car Park where there is a coach park (TR11 4DP).

Are there concessions available?

Unfortunately there are no concessions, however we do offer a 10% discount on groups of 10 or more on all group packages.

Do you provide a guided tour of the Museum?

Yes, we offer a guided tour of the Museum as part of the Silver Package, which also includes a souvenir guide book.

Is the museum wheelchair friendly?

Yes, the Museum is fully accessible with lifts to each floor, including the Tidal Zone and Lookout Tower. Please note that there is restricted access onto the boats as part of the Platinum Package.

Do I need to pre-book?
