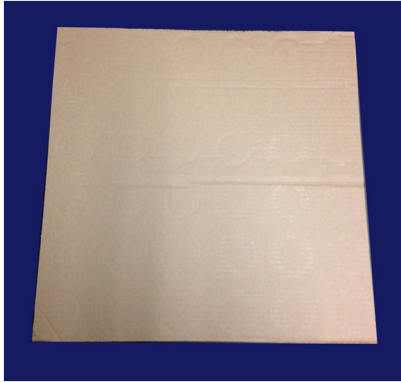
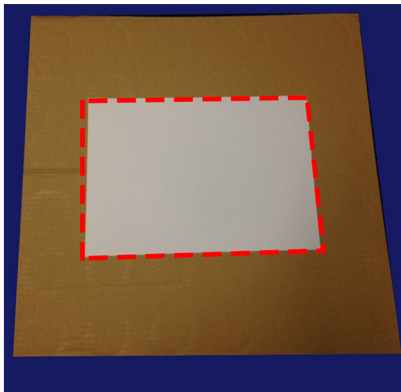


How to make a puppet theatre

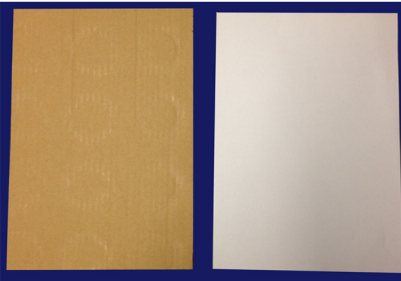
You will need: Corrugated cardboard, an A4 piece of paper, pencil, scissors and glue.



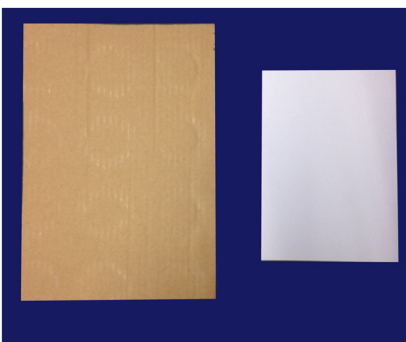
1. Find a piece of corrugated cardboard, perhaps from some packaging.



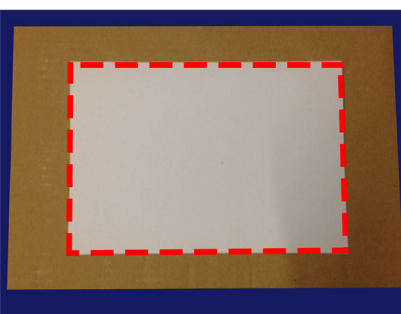
2. Place a piece of A4 paper on top of the cardboard. Use the paper as a template to draw around.



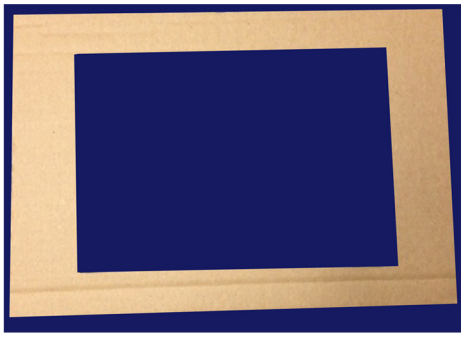
3. Cut the shape out. You should now have an A4 piece of corrugated cardboard.



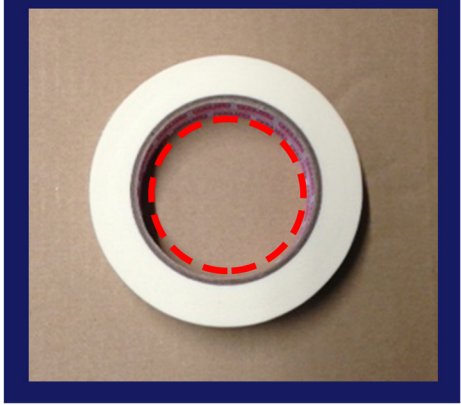
4. Fold the piece of paper in half.



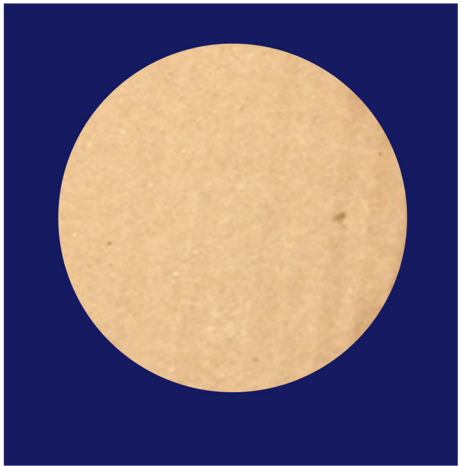
5. Place the folded piece of paper in the centre of the cardboard. Use the paper as a template to draw around.



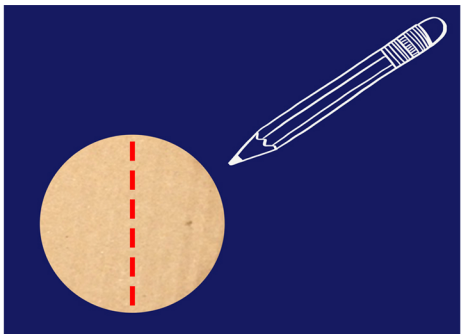
6. Cut the inside shape out.



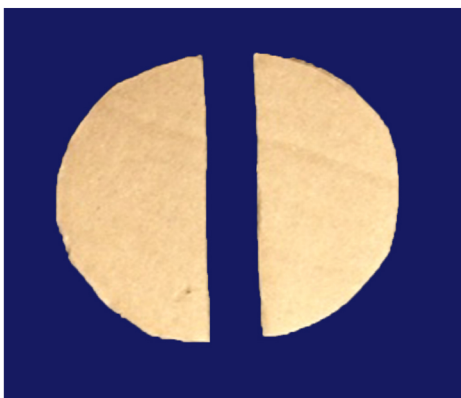
7. On a spare piece of cardboard draw around the inside of a roll of sticky tape or similar sized round object.



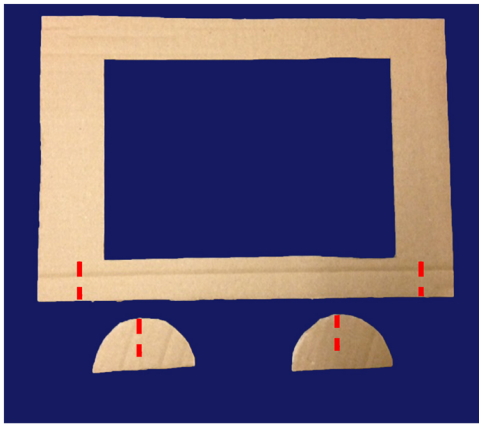
8. Cut the circle out.



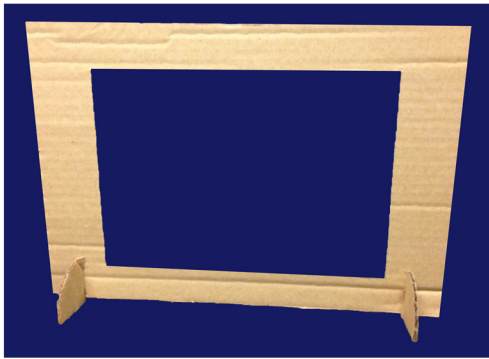
9. Draw a line dividing the circle in half.



10. Cut the circle in half.



11. Using this image as a guide mark four lines. Two lines on the frame and one line on each of the stands. The lines should be 2cm long. Don't draw the lines too close to the edge of the frame.



12. Cut along the lines you have drawn. Slot the stands into place to stand your theatre upright.

13. Decorate your theatre and act out your adventures for your family and friends to enjoy!
